Nominations may also be made by petitions submitted by members. Members who desire to name a nominee or nominees for a vacancy should prepare and submit a petition in accordance with the following procedures:

- Petition must be signed by 317 primary members of MidSouth Community FCU.
- Petition must be accompanied by a completed Volunteer Application as indication that the

person is agreeable to nomination and will serve if elected to office.

- The nominee must state his/her willingness to attend Board meetings and devote such time as is needed to fulfill this obligation.
- Petition must be filed with the Board Secretary of MidSouth Community FCU by November 14, 2014. Petitions may be left at the credit union and will be forwarded to the Secretary.
- Only members 18 years of age or older can be nominated for the Board and are eligible to vote.
