MidSouth Community is excited to announce the recipients of its 2015 Tom Bentley Memorial High School and Continuing Education Scholarship programs.

Taylor Brooks, of Milledgeville, was awarded the 2015 High School Scholarship. A graduate of Georgia Military College Prep School, Miss Brooks will attend Mercer University this fall and major in Biology. The high school scholarship is a \$4,000 award that is paid to the recipient's college or university in installments of \$1,000 per year.

It is United Way's goal that every school-age child will enter the summer months with a book of their own, and one that is age-appropriate to help combat summer-reading-loss.

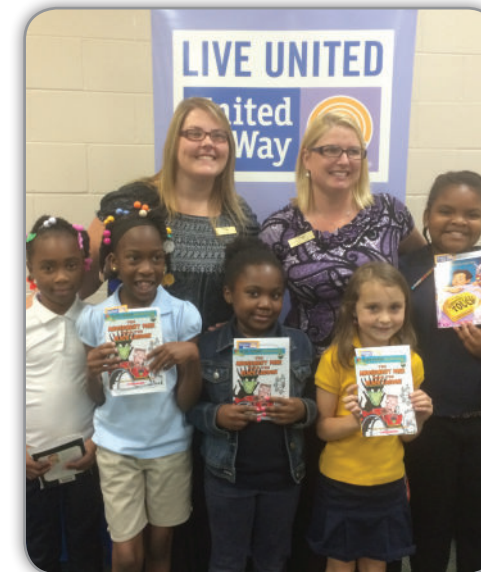
They aim to build home libraries for students and boost their literacy levels by retaining reading interest over the summer with fun and entertaining books.
